For someone without known diabetes, a hemoglobin A1c value between 5.7% and 6.4% is consistent with prediabetes and should be confirmed with a follow-up test. For someone with known diabetes, a value <7% indicates that their diabetes is well controlled. A1c targets should be individualized based on duration of diabetes, age, comorbid conditions, and other considerations. This assay result is consistent with an increased risk of diabetes. Currently, no consensus exists regarding use of hemoglobin A1c for diagnosis of diabetes for children.
